



Governing Council

The purpose of the Governing Council shall be:

- Serve as a resource for identifying member and industry issues for development of
- Institute strategy
- Receive and act on recommendations from the executive committee
- Final authority on decisions affecting Institute bylaws, policy and budget matters

The composition of the Governing Council:

- President
- President-elect
- Secretary/treasurer
- Regional vice presidents
- 75 elected at-large members
- 13 elected ARM representatives, one from each region
- IREM chapter presidents (U.S. and international)
- IREM Foundation president
- Members of the Institute's executive committee
- One representative named by NAR
- Past national presidents
- Any other members of the executive committee not named above

The terms of Governing Councillors shall be:

- At-large member terms are for three (3) years, on a staggered-term basis
- ARM representative terms are for two (2) years

The desired qualifications for Governing Councillors shall be:

- Broad knowledge of the Institute's goals, bylaws, policies, and programs
